Denver Union Station to Host Harvest Market Outdoor Market by Boulder County Farmers Markets to be Featured October 10, 2015

DENVER, CO-- Sept. 28, 2015—Denver Union Station will host a Harvest Market on Wynkoop Plaza on Oct. 10 from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. in partnership with Boulder County Farmers Markets, the Union Station Alliance, RTD and the Downtown Denver Partnership.

The Harvest Market at Denver Union Station will feature 10 Colorado farms, locally produced food items and fresh food dishes from Denver Union Station restaurants, including Mercantile Dining & Provision, Stoic & Genuine and Snooze - an AM Eatery. Participating Colorado farms include The Fresh Herb Co, Cure Organic Farm, Denver Botanic Gardens Chatfield Farms, Jodar Farms, Oxford Gardens and Plowshares Community Farm.

The Harvest Market will be organized by Boulder County Farmers Markets, a Boulder-based nonprofit organization that has operated producer-only farmers markets in Boulder County since 1987. "This first Harvest Market will enable Boulder County Farmers Markets and Denver Union Station to pilot the idea of hosting additional farmers markets at Union Station," said Brian Coppom, executive director of BCFM.

"As we approach the opening of the Commuter Rail line to Denver International Airport next spring, we are pursuing new ways to offer travelers and locals alike more quick and curated options at Denver Union Station," said Joe Vostrejs, partner in the Union Station Alliance. "We look forward to testing the Harvest Market to see if this is something the Denver and LoDo communities will utilize."

The Harvest Market will be the first and only outdoor market for Denver Union Station in 2015, to learn more about events held by the historic transit center visit www.unionstationinddenver.com.

Boulder County Farmers Markets are growers-only markets in Boulder and Longmont that support local farmers, ranchers and food producers. About Denver Union Station

Denver's Union Station is the "heart of the city" and Colorado's transportation hub, the more than 100-year-old building was restored and reopened in July 2014. The Great Hall of the station features a beer garden, ample seating and shuffle board tables as well as quick serve options MilkBox Ice Creamery, PigTrain Coffee, ACME Burger and Brat Corp., and Fresh eXchange wraps and salads. The Terminal Bar serves 30 Colorado craft beers and upstairs on the Union Station mezzanine is The Cooper Lounge, set as an above-ground, exclusive speakeasy. Retail selections include Bloom by Anuschka, Tattered Cover and 5 green boxes. In the north and

south wings of the historic building, is the 112-room Crawford Hotel and four Colorado-based restaurants: Mercantile Dining & Provision, Snooze an A.M. Eatery, Stoic & Genuine and The Kitchen Next Door. Union Station hosts Amtrak, light rail, RTD and other passengers on a daily basis and in 2016, the light rail from DIA will connect Denver to the world.
